

Day -1 Easter Condiments(p) Ltd, Adimali., Idukki Dt, Kochi Ranganathan and Mr. M.S. Sebastian. ECPL employs approx. 900 employees across its various regions - 40 management, 430 staff and 450 workers.

The company functions with the mission of "Unleashing potential to enable tomorrow's entrepreneurs"

In addition to the godown for raw material in Theni near Madurai (Tamil Nadu), Eastern has its own warehouse of 40,000 Sq.ft. for raw materials. A refrigerated storage facility of 90,000 Sq.ft. to store 3000 MT for chilli from Voltas Refrigerated Systems is fully functional at Theni. Apart from this, storage of approx. 10,000 Sq.ft. is available at Adimali (Kerala) for raw materials and 10,000 Sq.ft. for finished goods. Additional storage facility of 13,000 Sq. ft. is available at Kalady (Kerala). All warehouses are equipped with insect and rodent control devices including pheromone traps.

The students were provided the visit at the manufacturing plant located at Adimali, Idukki District, Kerala where the products such as pickles, spice powders, masala and coffee are being manufactured.

The students were explained about the process of manufacturing, lab testing, quality assurance and HR activities.

#### The Fertilizers and Chemicals Travancore Limited

The Fertilizers and Chemicals Travancore Limited (FACT) incorporated in the year 1943 was one of the first large scale fertilizer plants in India. Located at Udyogamandal, Kerala, FACT started production in 1947. Initially in the private sector promoted by the Seshasayee Brothers, FACT became a PSU in the year 1960 and towards the end of 1962, Government of India became the major shareholder of FACT. FACT has grown and diversified into a multidivision/multifunction Organization with core activities in manufacture and marketing of Fertilizers and Petrochemicals, Design, Engineering & Consultancy and in Fabrication & Erection of Industrial Equipment and Engineering works.

The students got a chance to learn about the process of manufacturing fertilizers, material handling and the various HR activities such as Public Grievances redressal and Welfare Measures, Security at Work & Corporate Social Responsibility.

#### Cochin Port

The Cochin Port, as it used to be in the past, keeps a close association with various industries like oil refinery, cashew and spices exports, marine and tourism. It has grown into become one of the prominent ports in India with over 1100 vessels reaching here every year. It also tankles about 13.5 million tons of cargo annuall M.I.E.T. ENGINEERING COLLEGE GUNDUR, TIRUCHIRAPPALLI 620 007.

The port lies on two islands in the Lake of Kochi: Willingdon Island and Vallarpadam, towards the Fort Kochi river mouth opening onto the Laccadive Sea. The International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT), part of the Cochin Port, is the largest container transshipment facility in India.

Cochin Port Trust<sup>1</sup> is an autonomous body under the government of India and is managed by Board of Trustees constituted by the government. The board is headed by the chairman who acts as the chief executive officer. The chairman is assisted by the deputy chairman who in turn is assisted by department heads and officials of the following port departments:

- General Administration
- Traffic
- Accounts
- Marine
- Civil Engineering
- · Mechanical Engineering
- Medical

The students got a chance to learn about the ships and the various types of containers.

#### Lulu Mart


It is owned by UAE based Lulu group, constructed at a cost of Rs 1,600 crore, at Edapally junction, Kochi in a 25 lakh square feet complex and was opened on March 10, 2013. It has top international brands of luxury, food courts, coffee shops, 22,000 square feet of entertainment zones, including a 5,000 square feet Ice rink, said to be the first of its kind in South India.

It has over 360 outlets, including food courts and restaurants and also houses the first McDonalds restaurant in Kerala.

The students learnt about the retail practices and the various brands available in the country. Also they had a chance to understand the promotional activities by the mart.
